Key to Comments

1. - Very rare (1 or very few known populations) in Santa Cruz Mountain Region (San Francisco to Pajaro River)
2. - Very rare (1 or very few known populations) in Santa Cruz County
3. - Uncommon or sporadic (or geographically limited) in Santa Cruz County
4. - Uncommon or sporadic (or geographically limited) in Santa Cruz Mountain Region
5. - Disjunct population (far removed from main range)
6. - Southernmost limit of distribution
7. - Northernmost limit of distribution
8. - Restricted to very specialized habitat type
9. - Limited to coastal zone (absent outside of coastal zone)
10. - Mostly limited to coastal zone
11. - Endemic to Santa Cruz Mountains
- * - To be expected (or possible) in coastal zone of Santa Cruz County, but no definite records as yet.

Level of Concern

- 1st priority - Assigned to narrowly restricted endemic taxa deserving official state or federal "endangered" or "rare" listing and expected to receive such listing eventually.
- 2nd priority - Taxa of particular local botanical and biogeographical interest, known from only one or few localized populations in Santa Cruz County or the Santa Cruz Mountain region (although they may be relatively common elsewhere); most of these are restricted to specialized habitat types which deserve careful protection.
- 3rd priority - Taxa of significant local interest because of their limited occurrence in Santa Cruz County or the Santa Cruz Mountain region, not as rare or highly localized as 2nd priority taxa, but still rare enough to deserve full protection.
