This information is not being sought after for any commercial purposes.

In the event we decide to review the information in person, please notify us of the address of the office where we could undertake that review.

This information should not be subject to exemptions from the FOIA, and access to the requested documents should be granted within 20 working days.

We also request that if you determine that any part of the information requested is exempt from the FOIA, this information be identified by document. We request that you provide statuatory basis for your claim and reasons for not exercising your discretion to release this information. FOIA also provides that if any portions of the file are exempt from release, the remainder of the file must be released. Therefore, we request that we be provided with any and all non-exempt portions that can reasonably be segregated.

In the event that you are unable to provide the information requested, please let us know within seven (7) working days so that further arrangements or appeals can be made.
